Welcome Spring with Liberty Open Golf Classic

Golf is in the air, after a brutal and bitter winter has left many of us longing to be outside in balmy, springtime weather. The Liberty Open Golf Classic is planned for May 10, 2019, and planning to participate is a fine way to welcome spring. It also supports the scholarship funds of the joint sponsors, the LHS Alumni and the Libertytown Unionville Lions.

This will be our third year holding the Classic at Glade Valley Golf Club, 10502 Glade Road, Walkersville, Md. The teams are lining up and sponsors have already started sending in their monies. Registration

There is a challenge issued to golfers from the captain of last year's winning team, Mike Crosby ('73). He and his teammates challenge Linganore grads to put a team together and "just try and stop us" this year.

A different challenge has gone out on our Facebook page for all alumni to sponsor at the

\$25 cart level. Cart sponsors will have signage made up with their name and graduation year placed on the carts used on the day of the tournament.

The Lions Club began holding it in 1996 and has distributed more than \$61,000 in scholarship monies raised by the tournament. Since 2005, the Linganore High School Alumni Association has been a cosponsor, and we have given scholarships totaling \$36,580.

Anyone interested in golfing is encouraged to join us. Registration will begin at 7:30 a.m., with an 8:30 shotgun start.

The entry fee of \$85 entitles golfers to driving range balls, a golfer gift, door prize tickets, a continental breakfast, snacks, beer, sodas, and a

buffet lunch at the golf club. Jake Trout, of Trout's grocery in Woodsboro, will handle all catering this year.

Mulligans, power balls, 50/50 raffle tickets, and additional door prize tickets are available at registration. We host a four-person team, Captain's choice tournament. Prize holes include double or nothing, a \$250 shootout, closest-to-the-pin contests on all par-3 holes, a longest drive award and a \$10,000 hole-in-one prize hole. Team prizes are paid to teams taking first,

second, and third place.

Old and new sponsors are always needed to make this tournament a success. Sponsor levels begin at \$25 for cart sponsors and increase to an upper level of \$2,500, for which the sponsor could rename the tournament. For \$150 or more, we will provide a banner to be displayed at the sponsor's business until the tournament, when our volunteers move the banner to the course. Discounts on foursomes are given at the \$250 (Eagle) sponsor level.
